**1. If a snare drum plays a steady pattern that makes you want to tap your foot, which element are you hearing?**

**Answer:** B) Rhythm

Rhythm is the placement of sounds in time, creating the 'heartbeat' or groove of a song.

**2. Dynamics refers to how fast or slow a piece of music is played.**

**Answer:** B) False

False. Dynamics refers to the volume (loud or soft), while the speed of the music is called tempo.

**3. The catchy part of 'Star Wars' that you can hum or whistle is called the \_\_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** C) Melody

The melody is a sequence of musical notes that form the main 'tune' people remember.

**4. Which term describes the 'voice' of an instrument, like why a flute sounds different than a tuba?**

**Answer:** D) Timbre

Timbre (pronounced TAM-ber) is the unique quality or tone color that distinguishes different sounds.

**5. When a guitarist plays three different notes at the same time to support a singer, they are creating \_\_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** A) Harmony

Harmony happens when different notes are played together to add depth to the melody.

**6. A lullaby usually has a slow tempo to help babies fall asleep.**

**Answer:** A) True

True. Tempo is the speed of music; a slow speed is calming, while a fast speed is energetic.

**7. If a composer wants a part of a song to sound like a quiet whisper, which element will they change?**

**Answer:** B) Dynamics

Dynamics control the volume of the music, ranging from very soft (piano) to very loud (forte).

**8. In a marching band, the big bass drum helps everyone stay together by providing a steady \_\_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** C) Beat

The beat is the basic unit of time in music that provides the steady pulse for rhythm.

**9. Imagine a violin and a electric guitar playing the exact same note. You can tell them apart because of their:**

**Answer:** A) Timbre

Timbre is what makes a 'warm' violin sound different from a 'fuzzy' or 'bright' electric guitar.

**10. If a song gets faster and faster, its tempo is increasing.**

**Answer:** A) True

True. Tempo measures the speed of the music; speeding up means the beat is moving faster.
