**1. In the sentence, 'The lunar rover slowly ascended the crater's rim,' which word is the adverb of manner?**

**Answer:** B) Slowly

'Slowly' is an adverb of manner because it describes the way in which the action (ascended) was performed.

**2. True or False: In the phrase 'a very cold morning,' the word 'very' is an adverb of degree modifying an adjective.**

**Answer:** A) True

Adverbs of degree often modify adjectives to show intensity; here, 'very' tells us the extent of the coldness.

**3. Identify the adverb of frequency in the following sentence: 'The team usually practices in the gym after the final bell rings.'**

**Answer:** C) Usually

'Usually' describes how often the practice occurs, making it an adverb of frequency.

**4. Which of these words functions as an adverb of place in the sentence: 'The curious cat ducked beneath the porch to hide'?**

**Answer:** A) Beneath

'Beneath' indicates the location or direction of the action, serving as an adverb of place.

**5. True or False: In the sentence 'I will call you later,' the word 'later' is an adverb of time.**

**Answer:** A) True

Adverbs of time tell us when an action happens; 'later' specifies a future point in time.

**6. Find the adverb in this sentence: 'The diplomat spoke quite eloquently during the global summit.'**

'Hardly' is an adverb of degree because it indicates the extent or intensity of the ability to see.

**8. Identify the adverb of time in this line from a journal: 'Yesterday, the archeologists discovered a hidden chamber.'**

**Answer:** A) Yesterday

'Yesterday' identifies the specific time point when the discovery occurred.

**9. True or False: Adverbs can only modify verbs.**

**Answer:** B) False

Adverbs are versatile; they can modify verbs, adjectives, and even other adverbs.

**10. Which adverb of frequency best completes this sentence: 'Since she loves silence, Jo \_\_\_ visits the noisy arcade.'**

**Answer:** B) Seldom

'Seldom' means rarely, which fits the context of someone who prefers silence avoiding a noisy place.
