1. Imagine a student who is always organized, keeps a neat desk, and never forgets their homework. Which 'Big Five' trait does this best describe?

Answer: B) Conscientiousness

Conscientiousness describes people who are organized, dependable, and disciplined.

The Superego represents our conscience and the social rules we learn from parents and society.

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6. A student who loves trying spicy new foods and traveling to unknown places would likely score high in _____.

Answer: A) Openness to experience

Openness to experience is a trait that defines how curious and adventurous a person is.

7. True or False: Trait theorists are more interested in 'why' a personality develops than 'what' the specific traits are.

8. What is 'Self-Efficacy' in personality theory?

The Id is the impulsive and instinctive part of the personality.
