**1. Which word means to 'play again'?**

**Answer:** C) Replay

The prefix 're-' means to do something one more time, so replaying is playing again.

**2. If you are 'full of soup,' you might say you are sup\_\_.**

**Answer:** D) -y

Adding '-y' to a word like soupy describes something that is like or full of that thing.

**3. The word 'jumped' means you are jumping right now.**

**Answer:** B) False

The suffix '-ed' shows that the jumping already happened in the past.

**4. If you are 'not happy,' which word should you use?**

**Answer:** B) Unhappy

The prefix 'un-' is like a 'no' button; it changes happy to its opposite.

**5. An apple that is 'not' ripe is \_\_\_ripe.**

**Answer:** B) un

Putting 'un-' at the start turns the word into its opposite, meaning 'not ripe'.

**6. What is the small word hiding inside 'helpful'?**

**Answer:** C) Help

Help is the base word or 'root' that gives the word its main meaning.

**7. Adding '-s' to the end of 'dog' means there is more than one dog.**

**Answer:** A) True

The suffix '-s' is a special ending we use to show there are two, three, or many things.

**8. If you look at a book 'before' you read it, you \_\_\_view it.**

**Answer:** C) pre

The prefix 'pre-' means 'before,' so a preview is looking at something before the final time.

**9. Which ending makes the word 'small' mean 'the most small'?**

**Answer:** D) Smallest

The suffix '-est' tells us that something is the 'most' of its group.

**10. A 'singer' is a person who sings.**

**Answer:** A) True

The suffix '-er' often describes a person who does a specific action, like singing.
