## Answer Key: Detective Dino's Time Machine: A Kindergarten Irregular Verb Challenge

Young learners reconstruct broken sentences by transforming action words and identifying why certain verbs change shape when moving from today to yesterday.

---

**1. Little Bear says, 'I run fast today.' How does he tell us he did it yesterday?**

**Answer:** C) I ran fast.

'Run' is a special verb that changes its middle sound to 'ran' when the action is finished.

**2. Finish the story: Today I give my teacher a flower. Yesterday, I \_\_\_ her a hug.**

**Answer:** D) gave

The word 'give' becomes 'gave' when we talk about the past; we don't add -ed to this word.

**3. If you ate a cookie yesterday, it is correct to say: 'I ate a cookie.'**

**Answer:** A) True

'Eat' is an irregular verb that changes completely to 'ate' in the past tense.

**4. The bird flies high today. Which word correctly tells us about the bird's flight yesterday?**

**Answer:** C) Flew

The past tense of 'fly' is 'flew', which is a unique spelling change.

**5. Pick the word that fits: I see a bug now. I \_\_\_ a giant spider at the zoo last week.**

**Answer:** B) saw

'See' changes to 'saw' to show the action already happened.

**6. Which sentence sounds correct for a story that happened a long time ago?**

**Answer:** B) The frog came to the pond.

'Come' changes to 'came' when we move from the present to the past.

**7. The past tense of the word 'go' is 'goed.'**

**Answer:** B) False

'Go' is very irregular! Its past tense version is 'went,' which looks totally different.

**8. If you tell a secret today, but you told one yesterday, the correct word is: \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** C) told

'Tell' changes its vowel sounds and becomes 'told' for past actions.

**9. Help the squirrel! He found a nut. Which sentence describes his discovery?**

**Answer:** C) He found a nut.

'Find' is an irregular verb that becomes 'found' in the past.

**10. I make a tower with blocks today. Yesterday, I \_\_\_\_ a big sandcastle.**

**Answer:** C) made

We change the 'k' to a 'd' to turn 'make' into the past tense 'made'.
