**Answer:** B) Sit under the shade of a big tree

Sitting in the shade is a way we change our behavior to stay comfortable in a hot environment.

**2. True or False: People wear rain boots and carry umbrellas to stay dry when it rains.**

**Answer:** A) True

This is true because we use special tools like umbrellas to adapt to wet weather.

To 'modify' means to change something. Digging paths for water changes the land to help plants grow.
