'Ephemeral' is a descriptive adjective meaning lasting for a very short time, providing a specific temporal context to the candidate's status.

'Arid' is a precise descriptive adjective indicating a lack of moisture or water, common in high school geography and literature.

**Answer:** C) Sequential demonstrative adjectives identifying specific items by order.

'Former' and 'latter' are demonstrative adjectives that specify which person or thing is being referred to based on their order in a sequence.

**10. In the sentence 'The precarious bridge swayed in the wind,' the word 'precarious' functions as a comparative adjective.**

**Answer:** B) False

False. 'Precarious' is a descriptive adjective in its positive form; it does not compare two things (which would be 'more precarious').
