1. If you see a friend fall and scrape their knee on the playground, what is the first thing you should do after making sure it is safe to help?

Answer: A) Tell an adult or teacher right away

At the third-grade level, the most important step in any first aid situation is to notify a trusted adult who can provide proper care.

2. True or False: You should wear a life jacket when playing near deep water or on a boat, even if you know how to swim well.

Answer: A) True

Life jackets are essential safety equipment that keep people afloat in emergencies, regardless of their swimming ability.
