Answer: B) The apple

Personal finance involves making choices between things we 'want' and things we 'need' to stay healthy.

Answer: B) False

Once money is spent, it is gone. This is a basic concept of scarcity and decision-making.

Answer: B) You cannot buy the toy right now

Answer: A) True

Sharing or donating is one of the three main uses for money: Spend, Save, and Share.

Answer: B) bigger

Answer: C) Water
