Answer: B) A comparative adjective phrase indicating a shift in quality

'More hospitable' is a comparative form used to show a relationship of degree between the current climate and the one being sought.

2. True or False: In the phrase 'the former candidate,' the word 'former' serves as a demonstrative adjective because it specifies which candidate is being discussed based on sequence.

Answer: A) True

Demonstrative adjectives like 'former' and 'latter' identify specific nouns based on their order or sequence in a previous mention.

3. Identify the most sophisticated adjective to complete this observation: 'The architect's ____ design utilized every inch of the tiny urban lot.'

Answer: B) ingenious

'Ingenious' is a descriptive adjective that adds precise qualitative detail about the cleverness of the design, fitting the advanced context.

'Most grueling' is a superlative adjective phrase, indicating the extreme limit of the quality being described.

'Myriad' describes an indefinitely large number, making it a sophisticated quantitative adjective.

Answer: C) Descriptive

'Melancholy' and 'desolate' describe the quality and mood of the nouns, categorizing them as descriptive adjectives.

Answer: C) yonder

'Yonder' is a sophisticated demonstrative adjective used to refer to something at a distance.

9. Which of the following sentences contains an error in adjective degree usage?

In advanced grammar, 'unique' is an absolute adjective (it means one of a kind); therefore, it cannot be comparative ('more unique').

10. True or False: The word 'scant' in the phrase 'scant evidence' is a descriptive adjective because it describes the quality of the proof.

Answer: B) False

False. 'Scant' is a quantitative adjective because it refers to the amount or scarcity of the evidence, not its inherent quality.
