In standard citation styles like MLA or APA, a colon is the conventional tool used to introduce a subtitle after the main title.

The Oxford Comma is the final comma in a list before the conjunction (and/or), used to prevent the last two items from being grouped incorrectly.

Answer: B) Em dash

The em dash is a versatile punctuation mark used for dramatic pauses, shifts in tone, or emphasizing additional information.

6. True or False: Every sentence ending in a question mark must be a direct inquiry directed at a specific reader.

Question marks can also follow rhetorical questions which are used for stylistic effect rather than to elicit an actual answer.

7. Identify the correct way to show plural possession for the word 'witnesses' in a legal context.

Answer: D) The witnesses' testimony

For plural nouns ending in -s, the possessive is formed by adding only an apostrophe after the final -s.

8. In formal dialogue, commas and periods should almost always be placed _____ the closing quotation mark.

Answer: B) Inside

According to American English standards, commas and periods are placed inside the closing quotation mark.

9. True or False: Brackets [] are primarily used inside a quotation to indicate that the writer has added their own clarifying words or edits to the original text.

Square brackets allow a writer to insert context or grammatical adjustments into a direct quote so it fits the surrounding sentence.

10. In the sentence 'The scientist discovered a never-before-seen element,' what is the purpose of the hyphens?

Answer: B) To create a compound modifier before a noun

Hyphens link multiple words together when they function as a single adjective leading into a noun.
