1. In a game of soccer, who is the only player allowed to use their hands to grab the ball?

Answer: B) The Goalie

The goalie (or goalkeeper) has the special job of protecting the net and is the only teammate allowed to pick up the ball with their hands.

2. When you are playing basketball and you move your feet without bouncing the ball, it is called _____.

Answer: C) Traveling

Traveling is a rule in basketball that says you must bounce the ball (dribble) while you walk or run.

3. True or False: In volleyball, your team can only hit the ball three times before sending it over the net.

Answer: A) True

Teams must work together to get the ball over the net in three hits or less to keep the game going.

4. Which of these is the BEST way to show good teamwork during a game?

Answer: B) Passing the ball to a teammate

Passing shows you trust your teammates and helps the whole team reach the goal together.

5. In baseball, the player who throws the ball to the batter is called the _____.

The pitcher is a key teammate whose job is to throw the ball toward the strike zone.
