**1. In the sentence 'The contemporary architect favored a minimalist aesthetic,' which word functions as an adjective?**

**Answer:** B) Minimalist

'Minimalist' describes the noun 'aesthetic.' 'Architect' is a noun, and 'favored' is the verb.

**2. Choose the correct comparative adjective to complete the sentence: 'The revised software update is \_\_\_\_\_ than the previous version.'**

**Answer:** C) More efficient

For multi-syllable adjectives like 'efficient,' the comparative degree is formed by adding 'more' before the word.

**3. The word 'those' in the phrase 'those vintage records' is a demonstrative adjective.**

**Answer:** A) True

'Those' is a demonstrative adjective because it points out which specific noun (records) is being discussed.

**4. Identify the superlative adjective in the following sequence: 'Fast, faster, fastest, quickly.'**

**Answer:** C) Fastest

Superlative adjectives typically end in '-est' and indicate the highest degree of a quality.

**5. Complete the sentence with the correct quantitative adjective: 'The chef added \_\_\_\_\_ salt to the soup, making it nearly inedible.'**

**Answer:** B) Excessive

'Excessive' describes a large amount that fits the context of being 'nearly inedible.'

**6. In the sentence 'She felt ecstatic after the performance,' 'ecstatic' is a descriptive adjective.**

**Answer:** A) True

Descriptive adjectives highlight qualities or emotions; 'ecstatic' describes the feeling or state of the subject.

**7. Which of these is a demonstrative adjective used to refer to a specific item far away?**

**Answer:** B) That

'That' indicates a single item that is at a distance from the speaker.

**8. Which word is an adjective in the sentence 'The grueling marathon left the runners exhausted'?**

**Answer:** C) Grueling

'Grueling' describes the noun 'marathon.' Note that 'exhausted' here also acts as a predicate adjective.

**9. Select the correct superlative form for the adjective 'bad.'**

**Answer:** D) Worst

'Worst' is the irregular superlative form of the adjective 'bad.'

**10. Quantitative adjectives like 'myriad' or 'abundant' tell us which specific one we are talking about.**

**Answer:** B) False

Quantitative adjectives describe 'how much' or 'how many,' not 'which one.' Demonstrative adjectives describe 'which one.'
