**1. A movie director wants a scene to feel very cold and snowy. Which fashion choice best helps the audience understand the weather?**

**Answer:** B) A heavy purple parka with fuzzy boots

Visual cues like heavy coats and boots communicate temperature and setting to the viewer without using words.

**2. If a famous singer wears a sparkly cape on stage, they want the audience to feel \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** B) Excited and amazed

Bright, sparkly costumes in pop culture are used to create high energy and draw attention during a performance.

**3. True or False: The music playing in a movie can change how we feel about the person on screen.**

**Answer:** A) True

Music is a formative tool used to signal whether a character is a hero (triumphant music) or a villain (scary music).

**4. Imagine a cartoon character who is a fast runner. What style of music would BEST match them running a race?**

**Answer:** B) A loud, fast drum beat

Fast-paced drums mirror the physical action of running, creating a cohesive sensory experience for the viewer.

**5. When many kids start wearing the same 'Space Robot' sneakers from a movie, it is called a \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** B) Trend

A trend occurs when a piece of fashion from media becomes popular and widely adopted by the public.

**6. True or False: If a movie character wears dark, tattered clothes and never smiles, the director likely wants us to think they are very happy.**

**Answer:** B) False

**8. If you see a character in a movie wearing a shiny silver suit and a helmet with lights, you can evaluate that they are likely \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** B) An astronaut from the future

Specific fashion trends in sci-fi films, like metallic fabrics, act as visual shorthand for futuristic settings.

**9. True or False: Wearing a jersey of your favorite sports team is a way of showing you belong to a 'fan' group.**

**Answer:** A) True

Fashion is a primary way individuals signal their identity and connection to specific cultural groups or movements.

**10. Which of these would be a 'hard' choice for a movie maker? If they want to show a character is a hero, but they make them wear a dark 'villain' cape.**

**Answer:** B) It might confuse the audience

This identifies a 'subversion' of a trend; when visual cues don't match expectations, it forces the audience to think harder about the character.
