Can you lead your teammates to victory? Evaluate tricky game scenarios and choose the best teamwork strategies to solve real sports problems.

1. Your teammate has the ball but two defenders are blocking them. You are standing all alone near the goal. What is the smartest thing to do?

Answer: B) Wave your hands and call for a pass

Moving to an open space and communicating helps your team overcome a 'double-team' defense.

2. In a team game, it is better for one person to score all the points than for everyone to share the ball.

Answer: B) False

Sharing the ball makes the team unpredictable and harder for the other team to defend against.

3. When your team loses the ball, you should immediately switch from being an attacker to being a _____ to protect your goal.

Answer: C) Defender

Transitioning roles quickly is a high-level strategy to prevent the opponent from scoring.

4. Imagine your teammate makes a big mistake and the other team scores. What is the best way to help your team play better in the next play?

Answer: A) Tell them it's okay and keep your head up

Positive communication maintains team morale, which is essential for collective performance.

5. Following the rules even when the referee isn't looking is called 'Sportsmanship.'

Answer: A) True

Integrity in sports ensures the game remains fair and strategic rather than chaotic.

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6. If you want to move the ball across the field very fast, the best strategy is to ____ it to a teammate instead of running with it.

Answer: B) Pass

The ball moves faster through the air or across the ground via a pass than a player can run.

7. During a timeout, the coach tells everyone to 'spread out.' Why is this a good strategy?

Answer: B) To make it harder for the other team to guard everyone

Using the 'spacing' strategy creates passing lanes and forces the defense to stretch out.

8. A good teammate only watches the ball and never looks at where their other teammates are standing.

Spatial awareness—looking at the whole field—is required for making tactical decisions.

9. In sports like hockey or soccer, the player who stays near the net to block shots is the ____, the last line of defense.

Answer: A) Goalkeeper

The goalkeeper has a specialized tactical role focused on shot-stopping and field organization.

10. The game is almost over and your team is losing by one point. What is the most effective way to try to win?

Answer: C) Work together to move the ball toward the goal quickly
