## Answer Key: The Secret Language of Busy Bees: A 1st Grade Adverb Quiz

Can you describe how a character moves or feels? First graders synthesize new sentences by choosing the best words to show how actions happen.

---

**1. Look at this sentence: 'The hungry bear ate the honey \_\_\_\_.' Which word makes the most sense to show how the bear ate?**

**Answer:** A) Greedily

'Greedily' is an adverb that describes the way the bear is eating, which fits the context of being hungry.

**2. Choose the best adverb to finish this sentence about a sneaky fox: 'The fox moved \_\_\_\_ through the tall grass so the birds would not hear him.'**

**Answer:** B) Quietly

If the fox doesn't want to be heard, he must move 'quietly.' This adverb describes the action of moving.

**3. In the sentence 'The sun shines brightly,' the word 'brightly' tells us WHERE the sun is.**

**Answer:** B) False

False. 'Brightly' tells us HOW the sun shines, not where it is.

**4. Which of these adverbs tells us WHEN an action happens?**

**Answer:** C) Soon

'Soon' is an adverb of time that tells the reader when something will occur.

**5. Create a better sentence! Change 'The turtle walks' to 'The turtle walks \_\_\_\_' to show he is not fast.**

**Answer:** C) Slowly

'Slowly' is the correct adverb to describe a turtle's pace and follows the 'how' rule for adverbs.

**6. The word 'Yesterday' can be used as an adverb to tell us when someone played at the park.**

**Answer:** A) True

True. 'Yesterday' is an adverb of time because it answers the question 'When did they play?'

**7. If a wizard waves his wand 'carefully,' how is he doing it?**

**Answer:** B) With great thought and safety

The adverb 'carefully' describes an action done with caution or attention to detail.

**8. Finish the sentence with an adverb of place: 'The kite flew \_\_\_\_\_ in the sky.'**

**Answer:** A) High

'High' describes the place or position of the kite, making it an adverb of place.

**9. Which sentence uses an adverb to describe how someone speaks?**

**Answer:** C) She whispered softly.

In this sentence, 'softly' is an adverb that modifies the verb 'whispered.'

**10. Many adverbs that tell HOW something happens end with the letters '-ly'.**

**Answer:** A) True

True. Adding '-ly' to an adjective (like 'quick' to 'quickly') is a common way to form an adverb of manner.
