**1. In formal academic writing, which sentence uses the past participle of 'fly' correctly?**

**Answer:** C) The research team had flown to the conference before the storm.

The verb 'fly' is irregular; its principal parts are fly (present), flew (past), and flown (past participle).

**2. The candidate \_\_\_\_\_ the podium and addressed the committee regarding the new policy. (Use the past tense of 'rise')**

**Answer:** B) rose

The past tense of 'rise' is 'rose'. 'Risen' is the past participle used with helping verbs.

**3. True or False: The past tense of the verb 'forecast' can remain 'forecast' without adding '-ed'.**

**Answer:** A) True

Like 'set' or 'put', 'forecast' is often used as an unchanging irregular verb in both past and present forms.

**4. Which of these verbs remains unchanged in its base, past, and past participle forms?**

**Answer:** A) Spread

'Spread' is an irregular verb where all three principal parts (spread, spread, spread) are identical.

**5. By the time the semester ended, the student had \_\_\_\_\_ every library resource available. (Use the past participle of 'seek')**

**Answer:** B) sought

'Sought' is the correct past participle for 'seek', following the same pattern as 'think/thought'.

**6. True or False: 'Ate' is the correct past participle for the verb 'eat'.**

**Answer:** B) False

'Ate' is the simple past tense. The past participle is 'eaten' (e.g., 'He had eaten').

**7. Identify the sentence that uses the correct past tense form of 'lie/lay' (lie/lay context) correctly.**

**Answer:** D) The intern lay down for a nap after the shift.

For the intransitive verb 'lie' (to recline), the simple past tense is 'lay'.

**8. The textile artist \_\_\_\_\_ the wool to create a sturdy fabric for the exhibit. (Use the past tense of 'weave')**

**Answer:** B) wove

'Wove' is the standard irregular past tense of 'weave'. 'Woven' is the past participle.

**9. True or False: The past tense of 'string' is 'strung'.**

**Answer:** A) True

'String' follows a vowel-shift pattern (string, strung, strung).

**10. The ship \_\_\_\_\_ beneath the waves after striking the reef. (Choose the correct past tense)**

**Answer:** A) sank

The simple past tense is 'sank'. 'Sunk' is the past participle used with 'has' or 'had'.
