**1. The Lion is very sleepy. He needs a mark that says 'Stop and rest.' Which mark is a full stop?**

**Answer:** A) The Period (.)

A period is like a red light; it tells the reader to take a full breath because the thought is finished.

**2. True or False: If a Monkey is shouting 'WATCH OUT!', we should use a tiny period instead of a tall exclamation point.**

**Answer:** B) False

Exclamation points are for loud or exciting feelings. A period is too quiet for a warning shout.

**3. The Zebra is wearing a necklace. To show the necklace belongs to the Zebra, we use an \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** A) Apostrophe (')

An apostrophe is a special flying mark that shows who owns something, like 'Zebra's necklace'.

**4. The Giraffe is confused! She is asking, 'Where is my tree?' Which mark should she use to show she has a question?**

**Answer:** C) A Question Mark (?)

Question marks are used whenever we are asking something we don't know the answer to yet.

**5. True or False: A comma (,) is used when the Hippo needs to take a tiny breath but is not done talking yet.**

**Answer:** A) True

Commas act like yellow lights; they tell us to slow down for a second before we keep going.

**6. The Elephant is naming his friends: Leo, Pip, and Dot. He uses \_\_\_\_ to keep their names separate.**

**Answer:** B) Commas

Exclamation points change the sound of a sentence to make it feel high-energy and exciting.

**8. True or False: Quotation marks ("" ) go around the words that come out of a character's mouth.**

**Answer:** A) True

Quotation marks are like 'talking hugs' that hold the words people say out loud.

**9. If we see a sentence that ends in a dot (.), the reader's voice should usually go \_\_\_\_.**

**Answer:** B) Down low

When we finish a statement with a period, our voice naturally drops to show we are done.

**10. Which of these marks is best for showing a very BIG, scary surprise in the jungle?**

**Answer:** C) The Exclamation Point (!)

Exclamation points are used for big emotions, whether they are happy surprises or scary ones.
