**1. Which word is a synonym for 'cautious' in the following sentence: 'The hiker was cautious as she crossed the slippery bridge.'**

**Answer:** B) Careful

Synonyms are words with similar meanings. Being 'careful' means taking the same kind of care as being 'cautious'.

**2. Select the correct word to complete the sentence: 'The \_\_\_\_ of the morning flowers was sweet and light.'**

**Answer:** A) Scent

'Scent' refers to a smell or aroma, which fits the context of smelling flowers.

**3. True or False: The words 'ancient' and 'modern' are antonyms.**

**Answer:** A) True

Antonyms are opposites. 'Ancient' means very old, while 'modern' means current or new.

**4. Choose the best antonym for the word 'expand' in the sentence: 'The balloon began to expand as it was filled with air.'**

**Answer:** C) Shrink

**Answer:** A) Brave

**8. Identify the antonym of 'clumsy' that best fits: 'The \_\_\_\_ dancer moved gracefully across the stage.'**

**Answer:** C) Skillful

If a dancer is moving gracefully, they are the opposite of clumsy. 'Skillful' is the best antonym here.

**9. Which pair of homophones correctly fits this sentence: 'I \_\_\_\_ that there was a \_\_\_\_ car in the driveway.'**

**Answer:** A) knew / new

'Knew' is the past tense of 'know' (understanding), and 'new' means not old.

**10. True or False: 'Success' and 'failure' are examples of antonyms.**

**Answer:** A) True

These are opposites; success is a positive outcome, while failure is the lack of success.
