**Answer:** B) The population had swollen beneath the pressure of urbanization.

While 'swelled' is common for the simple past, the past participle 'swollen' is the traditional choice in formal English for the perfect aspect.

**2. Choose the correct irregular form to complete the forensic analysis: 'Traces of the chemical were \_\_\_\_ to the surface during the reaction.'**

**Answer:** A) borne

'Borne' is the past participle of 'bear' used for carrying or transporting, whereas 'born' is reserved specifically for birth.

**3. True or False: In legal and historical contexts, the past tense of 'tread' is correctly written as 'trod'.**

**Answer:** A) True

The verb 'tread' follows the irregular pattern: tread (present), trod (past), trodden/trod (past participle).

The past participle of 'smite' is 'smitten'. 'Smote' is the simple past tense form.

'Rose' is the simple past tense of the intransitive irregular verb 'rise'. 'Raised' is the past tense of a different, regular verb.

**Answer:** A) True

While 'shrank' is standard for simple past, 'shrunk' is frequently used as the simple past in informal contexts and is the standard past participle form.

**10. Which sentence uses an 'unchanged' irregular verb correctly in a high-stakes context?**

**Answer:** B) The government set the interest rates early last year.

The verb 'set' is an unchanged irregular verb, meaning it remains 'set' in the present, past, and past participle forms.
