Can you tell a story about what you did this morning? Practice picking the right words for things that already happened using common action words.

1. Yesterday, I ___ my yummy apple at lunch.

Answer: C) ate

We say 'ate' instead of 'eated' when we talk about eating in the past.

2. The bird ___ away to its nest in the tree.

Answer: B) flew

For birds in the past, we use the word 'flew' because 'fly' is an irregular verb.

3. If you played a song on a piano yesterday, it is correct to say: 'I ran the bell.'

Answer: B) False

The past word for 'ring' is 'rang,' and the word 'ran' is for the verb 'run.'

4. The little frog ___ into the pond.

Answer: A) swam

'Swam' is the special word we use for swimming that happened before now.

5. My dad ___ me how to ride my bike last week.

Answer: C) taught

Instead of adding -ed to 'teach,' we use the special word 'taught.'

6. Is it correct to say 'I saw a pretty butterfly'?

Answer: A) True

'Saw' is the correct past tense form of the verb 'see'.

7. I ___ my milk at breakfast time.

Answer: C) drank

We say 'drank' when we talk about drinking something earlier today.

8. The boy ___ his favorite teddy bear to school.

Answer: B) brought

The past tense of 'bring' is 'brought.' It does not follow the -ed rule.

9. The past tense of the word 'go' is 'goed.'

Answer: B) False

The past tense of 'go' is 'went.' For example: 'I went to the store.'

10. I ___ my name on my paper! Look!

Answer: C) wrote

When you are finished writing, you say you 'wrote' it.
