**1. The marine biologist observed the pod of dolphins as \_\_\_\_ traveled across the bay.**

**Answer:** C) they

The pronoun refers to the 'pod of dolphins.' While a pod is a collective noun, in this context it refers to the multiple individuals acting together, making 'they' the most natural plural subject pronoun.

**2. In the sentence 'The telescope belongs to Maya,' the word 'hers' is a possessive pronoun that could replace 'to Maya.'**

**Answer:** A) True

'Hers' is a possessive pronoun used to show ownership without repeating the noun 'Maya.'

**3. Identify the indefinite pronoun in this sentence: 'Several of the artifacts in the museum are over a thousand years old.'**

**Answer:** B) Several

'Several' is an indefinite pronoun because it refers to an unspecified number of items rather than a specific person or thing.

**4. Which sentence uses a reflexive pronoun correctly to show the subject acting upon itself?**

**Answer:** A) The robot repaired itself after the collision.

'Itself' is a reflexive pronoun that correctly refers back to the subject 'the robot.'

Demonstrative pronouns 'demonstrate' or point to specific nouns based on their distance from the speaker.

Answer: B) me

After a preposition like 'between,' you must use an object pronoun like 'me' rather than a subject pronoun like 'I.'

7. Replace the underlined nouns with the correct plural possessive pronoun: 'The architects realized [the architects'] blueprints were missing.'

Answer: D) their

'Their' is the possessive adjective used to describe the blueprints belonging to the plural subject 'architects.'

8. In the sentence 'Everyone has their own locker,' the word 'Everyone' is a plural pronoun.

Answer: B) False

Technically, 'Everyone' is a singular indefinite pronoun, even though it refers to a group of people.

9. Which of the following contains an error in pronoun-antecedent agreement?

Answer: D) The tree lost their leaves during the first frost.

The noun 'tree' is singular, so the possessive pronoun should be 'its' instead of 'their.'

10. Choose the correct pronoun to complete the sentence: 'The captain and \_\_\_\_ mapped out the new trade route.'

Answer: B) he

'He' is a subject pronoun. Since the pronoun is part of the subject performing the action (mapping), 'he' is the correct choice.
