## Answer Key: Adverbial Analysis Quiz for 11th Grade

Analyze how nuanced modifiers shift the rhetorical weight of complex prose through these high-level diagnostic items.

**1. In the sentence 'The senator's speech was remarkably cogent, though perhaps overly polemical,' which word serves as an adverb of degree modifying an adjective?**

**Answer:** A) Remarkably

'Remarkably' is an adverb of degree that modifies the adjective 'cogent,' specifying the extent of the quality.

**2. True or False: In the phrase 'The results will be available shortly,' the word 'shortly' functions as an adverb of manner because it describes how the results are presented.**

**Answer:** B) False

'Shortly' is an adverb of time, indicating when the results will be available, not the manner in which they appear.

**3. Identify the adverbial phrase in the following sentence: 'Despite the criticism, the architect proceeded with the project \_\_\_\_\_, defying all expectations of failure.'**

'Nevertheless' is a conjunctive adverb used here to contrast the soundness of the theory with the lack of data.

**5. In T.S. Eliot's style of precision, which adverb of frequency would best emphasize a rare but significant occurrence? 'The protagonist \_\_\_\_\_ felt the weight of his own indecision.'**

**Answer:** C) Seldom

'Seldom' is an adverb of frequency that indicates a rare occurrence, which fits the prompt's requirement for a 'rare but significant' event.

**9. True or False: Sentence-level adverbs, such as 'Fortunately' in 'Fortunately, the storm bypassed the coastal village,' serve to modify the entire clause rather than a single verb.**

**Answer:** A) True

Sentence adverbs (or disjuncts) modify the entire thought or provide the speaker's attitude toward the event.

**10. Consider the sentence: 'The philosopher argued that morality is inherently subjective.' What is the linguistic purpose of the adverb 'inherently'?**

**Answer:** C) To indicate the essential nature of the quality described

'Inherently' is an adverb of degree/manner that modifies 'subjective,' identifying it as an essential, intrinsic characteristic.
