Verisimilitude is the appearance of being true or real. In creative writing, this is achieved through consistent logic and sensory detail, even if the world being described is fantastical.

Magical realism blends realistic narrative and naturalistic technique with surreal elements of dream or fantasy, where the characters accept these elements without surprise.

Answer: B) Metonymy

Synecdoche is a figure of speech in which a part is made to represent the whole or vice versa. It is closely related to metonymy and serves to condense meaning and add stylistic texture.

Answer: A) True

Aporia is a device where the writer expresses doubt or leads the reader to a point of philosophical impasse, often used in complex literary works to provoke deeper thought.

Answer: C) To reveal the character's innermost motivations and conflicts privately.
