Students analyze sentence mechanics by identifying adverbs of manner, degree, and frequency to add precision to their narrative writing.

1. In the sentence 'The solar-powered rover moved cautiously across the rocky Martian surface,' which word is an adverb of manner?

Answer: B) cautiously

'Cautiously' is an adverb of manner because it describes the specific way the rover was moving.

2. Choose the adverb of frequency that best completes this sentence: 'Since she loves astronomy, Maya _____ misses a chance to look through her telescope at night.'

Answer: A) seldom

'Seldom' is an adverb of frequency meaning 'rarely.' In this context, it shows how often she misses her hobby.

3. True or False: In the sentence 'The mountain climber was quite exhausted after the trek,' the word 'quite' is an adverb of degree.

Answer: A) True

True. 'Quite' modifies the adjective 'exhausted' by showing the intensity or extent of the tiredness.

Answer: C) The stray cat searched everywhere for food.

'Everywhere' is an adverb of place because it describes the location where the searching occurred.

5. Identify the adverb that modifies another adverb: 'The professional gymnast performed her routine extremely well.'

Answer: C) extremely

'Extremely' is an adverb of degree that modifies 'well,' which is also an adverb.

6. True or False: The word 'monthly' can be used as an adverb of frequency to describe how often a magazine is delivered.

'Finally' is an adverb of time because it indicates when the event eventually occurred.

'Somewhat' is an adverb of degree that explains the extent of the success.

9. True or False: In the sentence 'The majestic eagle flew above,' the word 'majestic' is an adverb.
