Can you spot the verbs that don't play by the rules? Build a strong foundation by identifying past tense words that change their shape completely.

1. Aptos the Alien ____ a shiny blue rock on his space walk yesterday.

Answer: B) found

The past tense of find is 'found.' It is irregular because we do not add -ed to the end.

2. Lily ____ her milk before heading to the playground.

Answer: C) drank

To show something happened in the past for the word 'drink,' we change the 'i' to an 'a' to make 'drank.'

3. True or False: The past tense of 'run' is 'ran.'

Answer: A) True

This is true! Instead of saying 'runned,' we change the word to 'ran' to talk about the past.

4. The busy bees ____ to the big sunflower garden this morning.

Answer: A) flew

Fly is an irregular verb. We change 'fly' to 'flew' when the action already happened.

5. Last night, my dad ____ a yummy chocolate cake.

Answer: D) made

The past tense of make is 'made.' We replace the 'ke' with 'de.'

6. True or False: If you 'sleep' last night, you can say you 'slept.'

Answer: B) False

False! Sleep is an irregular verb. The correct past tense form is 'slept.'

7. The little bird ____ a beautiful song for the forest.

Answer: C) sang

When we talk about singing in the past, we use the irregular form 'sang.'

8. I ____ a giant turtle at the aquarium last Friday.

Answer: B) saw

The past tense of see is 'saw.' It's a special word that doesn't use -ed.

9. True or False: 'Ate' is the past tense of 'eat'.

Answer: A) True

True! To show we ate food earlier, we move the letters around to make 'ate.'

10. Max ____ a letter to his grandma during class.

Answer: C) wrote

Write becomes 'wrote' in the past tense. This is another example of a vowel change in irregular verbs.
