**1. In academic writing, which sentence correctly utilizes an em-dash to signal a structural shift or emphasize a concluding element?**

**Answer:** D) Both A and C are grammatically correct uses of the em-dash.

Em-dashes can be used in pairs to isolate an internal list (A) or singly to provide a dramatic conclusion or summary (C).

**2. According to the Modern Language Association (MLA) style, a semicolon should be used to join two independent clauses even if they are connected by a coordinating conjunction like 'and' or 'but'.**

Independent clauses joined by a coordinating conjunction typically require a comma, not a semicolon, unless the clauses themselves are heavily punctuated.

For plural nouns ending in 's', the apostrophe is placed after the 's' to indicate collective possession.

**Answer:** B) It follows an introductory participial phrase.

Introductory phrases, especially participial phrases starting with a verb form, require a comma to separate them from the main clause.

**10. In the sentence 'The theory—while controversial—remains the standard in the field,' the use of em-dashes is an acceptable alternative to commas or parentheses.**

**Answer:** A) True

Em-dashes can effectively replace commas or parentheses to provide stronger emphasis to an internal non-essential element.
