Differentiate between descriptive, quantitative, and demonstrative modifiers to craft the sophisticated prose required for college-level rhetorical analysis.

1. In the sentence 'The former CEO's strategy was more effective than the current one,' which word functions as a demonstrative adjective indicating order?

Answer: C) Former

'Former' is a demonstrative adjective used to specify which noun is being discussed in a sequence, specifically the first of two mentioned.

2. True or False: In a high-stakes debate, using the word 'myriad' to describe a set of problems is an example of a quantitative adjective.

Answer: A) True

'Myriad' indicates an indefinite but large quantity, placing it in the category of quantitative adjectives.
