**1. An author writes a scene from the perspective of a jaded, elderly clockmaker using short, clipped sentences and technical jargon. This most specifically demonstrates which element?**

**Answer:** A) Narrative Voice

Voice is the distinct personality and perspective of the narrator, often shaped by their background, age, and attitude.

**2. True or False: In creative writing, 'style' refers only to the correct use of grammar and punctuation rules within a story.**

**Answer:** B) False

Style involves the author's unique use of language, imagery, and rhythm, often intentionally breaking standard rules to achieve an effect.

**6. When a poet chooses to write a 'Sestina' instead of a free-verse poem, they are focusing on the constraints of \_\_\_\_.**

A Sestina is a complex mathematical form of poetry; selecting it is a choice of structural form.

**7. True or False: Using a 'reliable narrator' is a common way to create suspense and surprise in a psychological thriller.**

**Answer:** B) False

In creative writing, an 'unreliable narrator' is actually the common tool used to create suspense and surprise by misleading the reader.

**8. If a writer utilizes 'Juxtaposition' in their work, what are they doing?**

**Answer:** B) Placing two contrasting things close together for effect.

Juxtaposition is a stylistic choice where two different elements are side-by-side to highlight their differences (e.g., a flower growing in a war zone).

**9. A screenplay consists primarily of dialogue and stage directions, making it a unique \_\_\_\_ of creative writing.**

**Answer:** C) Expression Form

Screenwriting is a specific format or form of expression, distinct from prose or poetry.

**10. Which of these contributes most to a writer's 'diction' in a creative piece?**

**Answer:** B) The choice of specific words.

Diction refers to the specific word choices an author makes to establish mood, tone, and character.
