'They' is the correct plural pronoun to replace a group of objects.

Answer: C) We

When you are talking about yourself and someone else, use 'we'.

Answer: D) They

'They' is used for plural nouns like 'stars'.

'She' is used for a girl; 'He' is used for a boy.
