## Answer Key: Don't Get Bent Out of Shape Over 8th Grade Irregular Verbs

Navigate future career communications by distinguishing between 'slid', 'slept', and other non-standard past tense forms commonly used in workplace correspondence.

1. The architectural team \_\_\_\_\_ a stunning blueprint for the new solar-powered library last week.

Answer: C) drew

The past tense of the irregular verb 'draw' is 'drew'. 'Drawn' is the past participle and requires a helping verb.

2. Identify the correct past tense form of 'freeze' to complete the sentence: After the sudden blizzard, the lake \_\_\_\_\_ solid overnight.

Answer: B) froze

'Froze' is the simple past tense of 'freeze'. 'Frozen' is the past participle used with helping verbs like 'has' or 'was'.

3. In the sentence 'The detective led the investigation,' the word 'led' is the correct irregular past tense form of 'lead'.

Answer: A) True

Unlike the metal 'lead' (rhymes with bed), the past tense of the verb 'lead' is spelled 'led'.

4. Which of these verbs remains exactly the same in its base form, past tense, and past participle?

Answer: A) Spread

The verb 'spread' is part of a group of irregular verbs that do not change form (spread, spread, spread).

5. Select the correct form of 'steal' for this historical context: The cunning thief \_\_\_\_\_ the crown jewels during the blackout.

Answer: C) stole

The simple past tense of 'steal' is 'stole'. 'Stolen' would require a helping verb like 'had'.

6. The past tense of 'mean' is 'meant'.

**Answer:** A) True

'Meant' is the irregular past tense and past participle of the verb 'mean'.

**7. Which sentence uses the irregular verb 'slide' correctly in the past tense?**

The irregular past tense of 'slide' is 'slid'. 'Sled' is a different noun or verb related to snow.

**8. Choose the correct past tense of 'keep': The witness \_\_\_\_\_ the secret for over twenty years.**

**Answer:** B) kept

'Kept' is the standard irregular past tense form for the verb 'keep'.

**9. Which of these is the correct past tense of 'shake'?**

**Answer:** B) Shook

'Shook' is the simple past tense. 'Shaken' is the past participle.

**10. The past tense of 'quit' can be either 'quit' or 'quitted', but 'quit' is more common in American English.**

**Answer:** A) True

'Quit' is an irregular verb where the past tense often remains identical to the base form.
