**1. When evaluating the credibility of a scientific report on oceanic biodiversity, which domain extension is generally considered the most reliable for academic research?**

**Answer:** C) .gov

Government (.gov) and educational (.edu) domains are typically more reliable for research data than commercial or general-purpose domains.

**2. True or False: In a Works Cited page, sources should be listed in the order they appear within your research paper.**

**Answer:** B) False

Modern citation styles like MLA and APA require bibliographic entries to be listed in alphabetical order by the author's last name.

**3. The primary purpose of an 'In-Text Citation' is to direct the reader to the corresponding entry on the \_\_\_\_\_ page.**

**Answer:** D) Works Cited

In-text citations act as a 'map' that connects a specific quote or idea to the full publication details found at the end of the document.

**4. If you are citing a digital article from a database and the author's name is not listed, what element should you use first in your citation?**

**Answer:** B) The title of the article

When an author is unknown, standard citation rules dictate that the title of the work moves to the first position of the entry.

**5. True or False: Summarizing a chapter in your own words still requires a citation to give credit to the original author.**

**Answer:** A) True
